Arts and Crafts Vendor Pow-Wow Guidelines & Restrictions

The undersigned agrees to the following details, descriptions, and restrictions.

1. Lasers, poppers, bomb bags, etc., animals, or outside firewood and open fires will NOT be allowed on Pow-wow grounds.
2. The sale of Ceremonial items such as Sage, Sweet Grass, Tobacco is strictly prohibited. Thank you.
3. Vendors are totally responsible for setup and removal of their own equipment, merchandise inventory, fixtures, and maintenance of their area, as well as removal of ALL trash.
4. Vendors will supply their own lights, chairs, tables, canopies, trash bags, water, and any supplies needed. Vendor MUST have their own generator, fuel to operate generator, and electrical cords. An Adult of 18 years of age or older must be present at the Vendor booth at ALL times. N.A.V.A. and the Pow-wow Committee will NOT PROVIDE any of the above mentioned. Vendor will not be allowed to use a power source provided by South Gate Park.
5. Vehicles are not allowed on Pow-wow grounds except for unloading or loading. All vehicles HAVE to be REMOVED when finished unloading. No vehicles will be allowed to park on Pow-wow grounds or else the vehicle will be towed at owner's expense.
6. N.A.V.A. and its board of directors are not responsible for theft, damage, or injuries assigned to the signed Vendor. Vendors assume liability for the above cases before, during, and after the event. A Hold Harmless agreement must be signed prior to setup. Thank you.
7. Possession of alcohol, drugs, or weapons on Pow-wow grounds or in the parking area is strictly prohibited. Offender will forfeit all fees and face expulsion from the Pow-wow and park facilities, and will face arrest by law enforcement.
8. Twenty-four hour security will be provided for POW-WOW GROUNDS ONLY. Vendors are still responsible for securing valuable merchandise, and will not hold N.A.V.A. and the Pow-Wow Committee liable for any theft, damage, loss, or injury.
9. Overnight parking will need a permit. Vendors needing a parking permit, please check the box on your signed agreement. Vendors will be given a permit upon check-in. Vendors will have assigned parking in a lot designated for Vendors. Thank You.
10. 75% of your merchandise must be handcrafted by Native American artisans. This is strictly enforced.

11. Booth spaces will be assigned. Moving your booth because you do not like its assigned location is NOT allowed. Spaces are limited.
12. Vendors must have a regulated fire extinguisher at their booth.
13. I have received the N.A.V.A., Fire Department, and Vendor guidelines.
